In addition to the Disadvantaged Business Enterprise and the Minority/Women Business Enterprise, we are encouraging all companies that qualify to apply for the Small Local Business Enterprise (SLBE) Certification Program.

I am applying for certification as a Small Local Business Enterprise (SLBE) under Chapter 38, Section 38-82.1 – 38-82.11 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Kansas City.

Advantages of SLBE Certification:

- Listings in KCMO's MWDBE Directory, this is updated daily and is accessible on the City's website at http://www.kcmo.org.
- Access to free workshops, seminars, and training classes
- Regional Electronic notification of contract opportunities, RFPs, and RFQs
- Bid incentives to SLBE firms that qualify
- Race & Gender neutral –open to all who qualify
- Establishes a sheltered market for small businesses to grow and compete among their peers
- No MWDBE goals applicable on eligible contracts

Requirements:

- The owner must possess at least 51% ownership, management, and control of the business.
- The owner must have the training/expertise to perform the work, and where required, have a license in his or her name.
- The firm must be independent and currently operating.
- The firm must be operating as for-profit.
- Principal place of business must be within the seven county Greater KCMSA (consisting of Cass, Clay, Johnson, Jackson, Platte, Wyandotte, and Leavenworth); and
- The firm maintains full time employees in one or more of the firm's offices within the KCMSA to conduct business or solicit business in the KCMSA the majority of the working time; and
- The firm has transacted business more than once in the KCMSA within the last two years.
- Firms are certified for 3 years and must submit annual updates, and notify HRD of any changes in ownership or control.
- The firm has annual gross receipts that, when added with those of its subsidiary or subsidiaries over three (3) consecutive years, do <u>NOT</u> exceed five percent (5%) of the applicable business size standard for the SBA General Contractor Classification NACIS Code 236220, or \$1.675M (5% of \$33.5M).

Airport Concession DBE (ACDBE) Certification Program

_____ I am applying for certification as an Airport Concession DBE (ACDBE) under 49 Code of Federal Regulations Part 23.

Requirements:

- The minority or female owner must possess at least 51% ownership, management, and control of the business.
- The minority or female owner must have the training/expertise to perform the work, and where required, have a license in his or her name.
- The firm must be independent and currently operating.
- The annual gross receipts for most firms (including its affiliates), averaged over the previous three year fiscal years, do not exceed \$52.47 million. Certain types of business have size standards that differ from the standard: (1) Banks:\$1.0 billion in assets; (2) Car rental companies: \$69.97 million average gross receipts over the firm's three previous fiscal years; (3) Pay telephones: 1,500 employees: (4) automobile dealers: 350 employees,
- Applicant must have a Personal Net Worth of less than \$1,320,000, excluding value of home and ownership interest in the business. There are no local presence requirements.
